

Travel Tips

Make return trip air reservations after 11AM as you will need time to get off the island – Going back to Woods Hole - last Ferry Saturday evening is around 7PM, first Ferry Sunday morning is around 6 AM . They run regularly through the day.



Whether you fly into Boston Logan or Providence you can ride the way the locals travel and board the Peter Pan Bus to Woods Hole to catch the Steamship Ferry. Or, check Peter Pan for routes from PA, VA, DC, NJ, NY and other Northeast destinations. They offer direct or connecting service to Woods Hole. The bus is very comfortable and rates are reasonable. The schedule is posted three months out and making a reservation is necessary. www.peterpanbus.com



Arriving at Woods Hole – the port to get over to the Vineyard. The Steamship Ferry is a heavenly ride if you stand on deck surrounded by ocean and take in the view as you approach the island. The 45-minute sail is truly the beginning of your R&R. Be sure to take the ferry that goes to Oak Bluffs. We are staying within walking distance or brief taxi ride. Vineyard Haven Ferry is a 15 minute taxi ride to the house. www.steamshipauthority.com www.mvol.com/ferries/

Or, if you fly into Providence Airport there is a shuttle to take you by bus to the Fast Ferry ride to the Island. www.vineyardfastferry.com



For those who want to get there even faster, you may fly from Boston Logan directly to the island. The only airlines I know of that flies to Martha's Vineyard is Cape Air. It is a little pricey www.capeair.com



First week only - S&D Coach Bus Transit from Pittsburgh and Harrisburg, New Jersey Bronx, New York - to and from the Steamship Ferry. Everything is included in the \$245 roundtrip fare. This Coach bus has WIFI, television, air and is operated by a company owned by one of the Sisters & Friends! Call 412-391-8208 for details



Driving to Woods Hole and putting your car on the Ferry to Oak Bluffs. You have to make a reservation and doing it early is best. Make round trip reservations. You can change dates and times later if they have space. Parking is not a problem on the island and doesn't cost. www.steamshipauthority.com

We are staying in the Oak Bluffs community of Martha's Vineyard. The airport is in West Tisbury. There are two ports where Steamships from Woods Hole dock, Oak Bluffs and Vineyard Haven. Best one to take is Oak Bluffs but if you take the Vineyard Haven Ferry there are taxis waiting for the 10 minute ride to the house.
